# Asbestos Refresher Courses

## UK Proficiency Modules (P)

BOHS refresher courses are aimed at asbestos workers, such as surveyors, analysts, managers and duty holders, who have previously taken one of the BOHS qualifications opposite:

<b>P404<sup>®</sup></b>	Air Sampling of Asbestos and MMMF and Requirements for a Certificate of Reoccupation Following Clearance of Asbestos
<b>P405<sup>®</sup></b>	Management of Asbestos in Buildings

## Available Courses

**RP402 Refresher** **Surveying and Sampling Strategies for Asbestos in Buildings** Enables candidates to revise and update their knowledge on all types of asbestos surveys, and to receive a certificate of course completion by passing a written examination, which covers both the theory and practice of surveying for asbestos in buildings.

**RP404 Refresher** **Air Sampling of Asbestos and MMMF and Requirements for a Certificate of Reoccupation Following Clearance of Asbestos** Enables candidates to revise and update their knowledge on air sampling and clearance testing techniques, and to receive a certificate of course completion by passing a written examination, which covers both the theory and practice of air sampling and clearance testing.

**RP405 Refresher** **Management of Asbestos in Buildings** Enables candidates to revise and update their knowledge on good asbestos management practices, and to receive a certificate of course completion by passing a written examination, which covers both the theory and practice of managing asbestos in buildings.

## Why Refresh?

BOHS refresher courses comply with the requirements outlined in the *Control of Asbestos Regulations (CAR) 2012*, which state that workers who undertake non-licensed asbestos work should have annual refresher training. HSE classes asbestos analysts and surveyors as non-licensed workers.

The requirement for yearly refresher training is also supported by HSE guidance documents *HSG264 Asbestos: the survey guide* and *HSG248 Asbestos: the analysts' guide for sampling, analysis and clearance procedures*; along with UKAS publication *LAB 30*.

## What do the Courses Involve?

Each course usually runs over one day, which includes six hours of face-to-face teaching time. There is a 60 minute exam at the end of the course, comprising of 20 questions. Candidates who successfully pass the exam will receive a certificate of course completion.
